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School Information

Coney Island Prep High School (CIPHS) believes that all students are entitled to a high-quality education through which scholars will be able to succeed in the college and career of their choice. Coney Island Prep High School makes use of rigorous academics, marked with frequent assessment and evaluation, in order to consistently set high standards for achievement and encourage students to overcome all obstacles. With high expectations for academics and behavior, and the supports and accountability measures to uphold those expectations, CIPHS provides a school culture that creates strong character, self-advocacy, and a responsibility to become life-long learners.

Community

CIPHS is a four-year public high school located in the Gravesend neighborhood of Brooklyn, and is the first charter school located in Community School District 21. CIPHS currently enrolls 340 students in grades 9-12, with 75 students in the senior class. CIPHS opened in September 2013 and graduated its first senior class in June 2017.

Curriculum

CIPHS follows a yearlong calendar. Scholars can earn up to 15 credits per school year. Yearlong classes are 2 credits. Semester classes are 1 credit. Classes are 57 minutes long on Monday through Thursday and 40 minutes long on Fridays.
