



Economically Disadvantaged	Coney Island Prep maintains a strong commitment to serving students and families in School District 21. Our recruitment efforts have included: 1) local subway and bus advertisements featuring students that reflect the community, 2) three rounds of CIP mailings to District 21 zip codes, 3) localized social media advertisements, and 4) on-foot canvassing to reach families (in lieu of in-person open houses due to Covid restrictions) As a result of these efforts, 70% of our applications came from School District 21, a sharp increase from only 49% the year prior. Overall, 85% of our students were considered economically disadvantaged. This number is higher than the number served in our district (75%, last reported for 2020- 2021).	In addition to the methods we traditionally use (print and virtual advertisements, mailings, and open houses), we will continue to invest in community canvassing events, particularly on Coney Island proper where residents are hit most by economic hardship. These events will serve as strong opportunities for school staff to engage with the community, talk to residents about our school, and encourage them to apply. With the help of our local partnerships, we will also monitor community events throughout the summer so that we can continue to spread the word about our school. Lastly, we recognize that family referrals make up a large percentage of our application base. 


