

Founded in 2013, Coney Island Prep High School is a free, public, rigorous college preparatory public charter school located in south Brooklyn and is the first charter school located in Community School District 21. CIPHS enrolls approximately 350 scholars in grades 9-12, with 68 scholars in the senior class. Since its first graduating class in 2017, every Coney Island Prep senior graduates with college acceptances in hand. We believe that their experiences, both inside and outside the classroom, are assets to be leveraged in learning and that our school must prepare scholars for the colleges and careers of their choice.

DEMOGRAPHIC:

Coney Island Prep enrolls 350 high school scholars, including 68 seniors, many of whom have attended our schools since the 5th grade. Our scholars enrich our classrooms with their diverse experiences and backgrounds.

- 83% are eligible for free or reduced-priced lunch
- 75% are first-generation college applicants
- 39% are Black
- 30% are Latinx
- 14% are Asian
- 9% are White
