



Founded in 2013, Coney Island Prep High School is a free, public, rigorous college preparatory public charter school located in South Brooklyn and is the first charter school located in Community School District 21. CIPHS enrolls approximately 400 students in grades 9-12, with 83 students in the senior class. Since its first graduating class in 2017, every Coney Island Prep graduate leaves with a college acceptance in hand. We believe that their experiences, both inside and outside the classroom, are assets to be leveraged in learning and that our school must prepare students for the colleges and careers of their choice.

DEMOGRAPHICS

Coney Island Prep (CIP) enrolls 403 high school students, including 83 seniors, many of whom have attended our schools since the 1st grade. Our students enrich our classrooms with their diverse experiences and backgrounds:

- **80%+** are eligible for free or reduced-priced lunch
- **75%** are first-generation college students
- **39%** are Black
- **31%** are Latinx
- **12%** are White
- **7%** are Asian
- **11%** are Multiracial

DUAL-ENROLLMENT

64% of our 2025-26 senior class have taken college credit-bearing courses, including dual-enrollment programs through the National Education Equity Lab at Arizona State University and Advanced Placement courses. 90% of seniors are on track to complete college credit-bearing courses by graduation.

- Advanced NYS Regents Diploma: 44 academic credits; 65 or higher on eight or more NYS Regents Exams.

Coney Island Prep believes that every graduate has a right to pursue higher education. Our job is to ensure scholars have that opportunity and are prepared to succeed. CIP graduates persist and graduate from college at over six times the national average for first-generation, low-income students. CIP is committed to continuing to support our students even after graduation, providing additional layers of alumni support to supplement support from their colleges and universities and to ensure their continued academic success in college.
