Quill is a platform that provides writing and grammar activities for our students to strengthen their writing and grammar skills. Each week your scholar will earn a Quill completion grade, please support us at home by asking your scholar about their Quill completion. Scholars should complete 4 or more lessons per week. If your scholar fails a lesson, then can re-submit for a better score. You can monitor their Quill completion by having them log on to their Quill account and show you the number of lessons they have completed for the week.
